

# **CERTIFIED SOFTBALL ADMINISTRATOR PROGRAM (CSAP)**

## **MASTER LEARNING FACILITATOR**

### **ROLE DESCRIPTION**

#### **The Master Learning Facilitator is responsible for:**

- Conducting Learning Facilitator Training Workshops
- Evaluating Learning Facilitators
- Conducting a minimum of two CSAP Workshops annually
- Conducting a Learning Facilitator Update Session annually
- Directing suggested Program amendments and modifications to the Participation Committee Member responsible for CSAP and the Participation Program Co-ordinator
- Committing to the Program for two years
- Recommending potential Learning Facilitators
- Recommending potential Master Facilitators
- Promoting awareness of CSAP and the S.A.F.E. Star program

### **MINIMUM STANDARDS**

#### **To be eligible for Master Facilitator, in addition to the Learning Facilitator**

#### **Certification requirements, the candidate must:**

- Be recommended by a Master Facilitator along with the Participation Committee Member responsible for CSAP or the Participation Program Coordinator
- Have conducted one workshop in all CSAP modules under the evaluation of a Master Learning Facilitator along with the Participation Committee Member responsible for CSAP or the Participation Program Coordinator
- Sign Softball Ontario Volunteer Application and Confidentiality Agreement
- Adhere to Softball Ontario Policies & Procedures
- Have working knowledge of the game of softball
