

Fast Pitch Clinic Instructor
JOB DESCRIPTION

Major Objective/Purpose

- a. To instruct at Softball Ontario Fast Pitch umpire clinics as assigned

Qualifications

- a. Should have completed a certified clinic at least one level above the one they are teaching – in Fast Pitch
- b. Demonstrate above average teaching ability
- c. Have excellent knowledge of content and program – in Fast Pitch
- d. Have the ability to analyze and correct basic mechanics and skills of the game of softball
- e. Have the ability to evaluate and constructively criticize future instructors
- f. Have the ability to teach adults effectively in an enjoyable atmosphere
- g. The individual must be an active Fast Pitch umpire registered with Softball Ontario by April 15 of each year. If not registered by April 15 of the current year, the FP PUIC has the right to remove the volunteer from his/her duties.
- h. Must complete a Softball Ontario Volunteer Application.
- i. Must sign Association's Confidentiality Agreement prior to March 31st and/or prior to assumption of duties. Refusing to sign agreement – they will not be permitted to be a volunteer for Softball Ontario's FP Umpire Program.
- j. Have attended a Softball Canada Instructor/Evaluator Clinic is an asset.

Responsibilities

- a. Must be available as an instructor for at least two Fast Pitch clinics if required within their zone
- b. Ensure all clinic registration forms, clinic evaluation forms, expense claim forms, etc. are filled out completely and returned to the Softball Ontario office immediately following the clinic
- c. Assist in the improvement and updating of the present programs
- d. Continually update and expand knowledge of Softball Ontario and all its programs
- e. To carry out their duties consistent with the expectations and practices of the umpires' program

Commitment/Duration of the Job

- a. This is a one-year appointment and instructors must re-apply yearly

Supervisor

- a. The Fast Pitch Instructor reports directly to the Fast Pitch Zone Umpire-in-Chief

Orientation/Training

- a. Instructor must attend the provincial or zone Instructor Training Meeting prior to the softball season.
