

CANpitch – Regional Pitching Instructor – Job Description

Major Objective/Purpose:

Primary role is to be the pitching expert in their region in Ontario. To be responsible for delivering the six-week training session for both players and coaches. Will also support and mentor pitching coaches within their region in Ontario. Shall play a key role in assisting Softball Ontario with the delivery and implementation of the CANpitch program.

Qualifications:

- a. Must sign Softball Ontario's Confidentiality Agreement.
- b. Must Complete a Softball Ontario Volunteer Application.
- c. Must sign Softball Canada's Agreement.
- d. Approved by Softball Ontario's CANpitch Committee
- e. Agree to submit a Police Records Check to Softball Ontario and be approved prior to attending any training sessions with athletes.
- f. Must have a valid and full driver's license.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- a. Responsible for delivering one (1) six-week clinic per clinic season.
- b. Mentor local pitchers and coaches in their region in Ontario- must be pre-approved by Softball Ontario's Pitching Committee
- c. Attend all training sessions, workshops and participate in conference calls hosted by Softball Ontario, when necessary.
- d. To communicate regularly with Master Pitching Instructors and Softball Ontario about the CANpitch program.
- e. Provide Softball Ontario feedback about the CANpitch program in regards to format, content and delivery.
- f. To provide recommendations and feedback for revisions about the CANpitch Curriculum to Softball Canada through the Softball Ontario office.
- g. To assist Softball Ontario and Master Pitching Instructor in writing an annual report for Softball Canada providing data about the program and summarizing the feedback from players, coaches, and fellow Regional Pitching Instructors regarding the CANpitch program.
- h. To promote the CANpitch program to local softball associations in their region.
- i. To be accountable for responsibilities to Softball Ontario.
- j. To submit CANpitch session attendance forms along with the Softball Ontario expense form to the Softball Ontario office when the clinic is complete.

Commitment/Duration of the Job:

The position of Regional Pitching Instructor is appointed for a period of two years. Must commit to deliver at least one (1) six-week training session per clinic season. Instructor progress will be reviewed annually by the Softball Ontario CANpitch Committee as per program reports. If Softball Ontario CANpitch Committee feels that the Instructor did not fulfill their job duties and responsibilities and does not have a valid reason, the Committee will ask for all CANpitch Program materials to be returned to the Softball Ontario office and will no longer be a volunteer for the CANpitch Program.

Supervisor:

The Regional Pitching Instructor is appointed by the Softball Ontario Pitching Committee and is responsible to the Chairman of the Pitching Committee and the Program Coordinator.

Orientation/Training:

- a. Must attend Regional Pitching Instructor Training every two years unless requested otherwise by the Softball Ontario CANpitch Committee.
- b. Be receptive to constructive criticism and evaluations directed to improve your skills as an instructor.
