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## **Softball Ontario On-Field Evaluation Performance Levels**

#### Level 1

- Softball Ontario carded
- Must have previously attended Level 1 Certification Clinic
- Demonstrates mechanics at a level consistent with those instructed at Level 1 Clinic
- Demonstrates an interest in the game and in developing as an official
- Attempted to adopt any recommendations made during the evaluation process

### **Level 2B** FP Only:

- Must have previously attended Level 2 Certification Clinic

#### FP and SP:

- Demonstrates mechanics at a level consistent with those instructed at Level 2 Clinic
- Some areas of performance are below acceptable level but improvements were noted
- Clinic materials require review and evaluation suggestions need to be implemented

### Level 2A SP Only

- Must have previously attended Level 2 Certification Clinic

#### FP and SP:

- Demonstrates more consistency of Level 2 mechanics than a 2B umpire
- Willing to accept constructive criticism and adopt evaluation recommendations
- Most areas of performance are at an acceptable level but some areas require improvement

#### Level 3B

## FP Only:

Must have previously attended Level 3 Certification Clinic

#### FP and SP:

- Demonstrates mechanics and rules knowledge consistent with those instructed at Level 3 clinic
- Demonstrates more consistency than a Level 2 umpire
- A few areas of officiating skills require instruction and improvement
- May only be granted by ZUIC/PUIC/DUIC/Umpire Committee Members
- May only be granted at Midget Rep F.P. (or higher) or Adult Competitive S.P.

#### Level 3A

## FP and SP:

- Must have previously attended Level 3 Certification Clinic
- Clearly surpasses expected requirements and has no major deficiencies
- Mechanics are demonstrated consistently in all game situations
- Could be a Level 4 umpire with some "polishing" of mechanics
- May only be granted by PUIC/DUIC
- May only be granted at Midget Rep F.P. (or higher) or Adult Competitive S.P.
- In S.P. may only be granted in 2/3 umpire system (not single umpire)

## Level 4B

#### SP Only

- Must have previously attended Level 4 Certification Clinic
- Evaluation by Softball Ontario PUIC/DUIC
- Performs all mechanics and makes rule interpretation consistent with provincial and national standards
- A positive influence on the field demonstrating strong game control skills
- Demonstrates greater on diamond "polish" and consistency than a 3A official

## Level 4

#### FP and SP:

- Must have previously attended Level 4 Certification Clinic
- Softball Canada Evaluation and Recommendation following a Canadian Championship that indicates the umpire is capable of Jr Men, Sr Women or Sr Men in F.P. / Sr Men or
- Masters over 35 in S.P.

## Level 5

- Softball Canada Evaluation and Recommendation following selected Canadian Championship tournaments
- Note: \*1 Softball Ontario Level is based on the lower of the OFE and Clinic Certification Level
- Note: \*2 All evaluations which indicate a change in OFE require approval by ZUIC or by the PUIC/DUIC/ Umpire Committee Chair
- Note: \*3 All changes in OFE level are recorded by the Softball Ontario office at the end of the season. New cards will not be issued to reflect OFE changes. Changes will be reflected on the next season's card.
